

Unlock your child's potential: Strategies for after-school tutoring that work



01 Define clear objectives for each tutoring session

Identify 1 – 2 learning objectives that target the student's needs.



02 Prioritize foundational skill building

Provide a smooth entry point into more complex tasks by using some of the tutoring time to address gaps in basic skills



03 Avoid using tutoring time solely for homework completion

Use homework to identify misconceptions. Extract sample problems from homework to teach the concepts.



04 Incorporate Active Learning strategies

Encourage the student to think critically by asking them open-ended questions.



05 Monitor progress and adjust plans accordingly

Track the student's progress and modify plan as needed.
